Gallery Review

The Anona Gallery

Located at 14 Main Street in Winters, features the work of the Gallery owner, Anona Neville. She does large, imposing abstracts, mostly shiny acrylics, and collages. Most are rendered in a limited palette - greys, blues and black. Housed in an old Victorian building, with mottled brick walls and a rustic wood floor, the restored interior makes for an inviting viewing space.

A couple of works stand out - "True Wish" (36 "x 12") is a large, narrow acrylic, done in seafoam greens and blues. The scene depicts a large swatch of ocean foam. Several other of the artist's works resemble this piece.

"Mama and Baby Orca" is another imposing, semi-realistic rendering of nature, water, and animals; in this case, whales. The artist's drip technique captures, with gestural strokes, the flowing, streaming endless quality of the sea and its wildlife.

Anona Gallery has occasional guest artists, but mostly her gallery is devoted to her own work. The Gallery is a working studio for the artist as well. The Artist also gives immersive art instruction, where her students can explore their creativity and connect with painting and abstraction on a deeper level.

Neville has an eclectic and versatile style and works with a variety of subject matter - portraits, mixed media, collage, seascapes, landscapes as well as pure abstracts. Her Gallery is located in the Winters Historic District, in an area filled with picturesque Victorian buildings and boutiques, with old houses and endless small parks. A fun place to visit and experience art.
