Napa Art Gallery

Located at 1307 First Street, the Napa Art Gallery is a small, intimate viewing space in downtown Napa. Featuring the work of local artists, the Gallery features drawings, caricatures, paintings on wood, ceramics, jewelry, photography as well as florals, portraits and landscapes.

A few artists stand out: Cathy Kough, who creates colorful glass jewelry items, often in bright, deep blue colors. Cindy Taylor produces florals and still lifes and artist Debbie Ames has one work, a large graphic of a guitar rendered in steely gray colors which has an almost magical pop art aura.

Craftswoman Gerda Shupe creates
wooden cutting boards and other accessories
with fine, flowing abstract designs.
Katrina Gocan paints fine florals, closeups of
flowers and plants. Artist Marilyn Smith
produces large, sculptural jewelry pieces in
a variety of materials and bright colors.
Susan Segal has bright, colorful images of
flowers, especially sunflowers.

For such a small viewing space, the Napa Art Gallery manages to spotlight a large variety of styles, materials, and artistic approaches.
