

Gallery Review By Adrienne Emmering

The RioVision Gallery

Located at 116 Main Street in Rio Vista (*along the Sacramento River*) is a small, intimate gallery located in the area's old town. The Gallery features a wide variety of arts, crafts, and small items, like greeting cards. An extensive jewelry collection features the work of Susan Prince, who works with a variety of materials - beads, polymer clay, crystal beads, and found objects. One item is a standout - a large, beaded strand with a massive shell pendant. Red and black is the work's theme. Ms. Prince also works with seed beads and semi-precious stones.

Another artist, watercolorist Kathie Boissiere, uses vivid, bright colors. One of her works, "Figment" combines bright pastels and yellows with collage to create a dynamic city scene. Abstract and glowing, this work seizes the viewer's attention as soon as he walks in the door.

"Fishin' Time" by Dorie Solomon is a homely boat scene. A traditional watercolor, it is a standout in that genre. The style she uses is midway between traditional realistic and impressionistic painting. A small gift shop occupies the back room and has a collection of scarves, ceramics, wreaths, and small artworks. In the front area, a collection of decorated gourds (*by Diana Peugh*) uses an ancient art form, often used by native Americans, to make some very modern, dynamic artworks.

On the third Saturday of each month there is a featured artist reception, from 3 to 5 pm. An interesting fine art venue in an area not generally known for art activity.
