Gallery Review

The Firehouse Art Center, located at 4444 Railroad Avenue in Pleasanton, California, features a smallish gallery, The Harrington Gallery. The Harrington plays host to a variety of seasonal art shows. Their current offering, 'Colors of Summer' is on until July 27. The upcoming show 'Rails Connect' will spotlight artworks relating to the local railroad system and its history.

The current show has colorful works by several artists. One painter, James Ong, uses mixed media (*mostly acrylic*) to build up complex textures and shapes. In one item, 'The Shape of Things to Come,' Ong creates compelling abstract shapes with a light touch. Using light pinks, yellows, pastel greens, and light blues, he creates a dreamy haze of sunny dots and brilliantly colorful circular shapes.

Artist Jen Norton creates large watercolors and acrylics of brightly colored flowers and fruits oranges and yellows seem to be a predominant theme. One item is nothing but oranges in crates with brilliant orange color everywhere.

Sandi Okita does fine mixed media work. Her palette is limited: greys, dark blues, and yellows. Artist Julia Watson does flowers, mostly oils rendered in white and red. One Summer Reds; is a portrait of a large red rose, done in oil. Another painter, Veronica Gross, does fine watercolors of florals, seascapes, and portraits. Her palette runs to complementary colors - blues, vivid yellows, and subtle greys.

Joie McClements has one impressive acrylic, a large piece called 'Sunset Roses,' a large, ambitious work of abstracted white roses.

Lastly, artist Nancy Takaichi favors oils. Her style is muted and very subtle. 'Tank House'" is a summary of California landscape with an antique building featuring lots of delicate blues, greens, and greys. Another item, 'Lanvie Outlet' is an equally dreamy landscape. The show lives up to its name - there are lots of colors of summer here, indeed.
