

Gallery Review

The Pence Gallery

The Pence, located at 212 D Street in Davis, is a large, imposing viewing space, with an upstairs and downstairs and a gift shop which looks to be another gallery all by itself. Replete with ceramics, one-of-a-kind jewelry items, small paintings and graphics, the shop alone is worth a visit. The upstairs features more art. Currently, the upstairs gallery has a nice display of watercolor paintings by local artist, Misuk Goltz. The Pence also hosts various art classes (*watercolor, acrylics, drawing*) and a city garden tour.

A recent show featured the work of Joseph Bellacera, who creates large abstract works, some of which incorporate scientific themes with colorful abstract images (oblongs, spheres, dynamic patterns). One item, 'Celebration in Orange #2', a mixed media piece, features bright patterns, rendered in vivid contrasting colors (oranges, blues, blacks and greens), a wild festival of vivid shapes that seems to soar through space.

Another featured artist, Christina Kent, does large, very spare oils, figurative works of urban landscapes, interiors, intimate scenes and parks. Her colors are soft – everything seems bathed in subtle shadows and muted light. There are dark sunsets with hazy grey skies. Her colors are mostly earth tones, accented with subtle blues and purple skies and shadows, her palette is distinctive. One piece, 'Grab a Bite' is a large oil depicting an intimate, yet strangely lonely scene set in an urban diner.

Another featured artist, Gina Werfel, does large abstracts on paper. Her style is distinctive, the works done in vibrant neon colors (*lots of vivid light yellows and reds*). She layers the pieces with bits of collage and stenciled and brush stroked images that seem to tilt and shimmer, giving her pieces a vibrant quality, a sense of movement, a light and joyous aliveness. One work, 'Fabric,' seems to dance and fairly explode off the paper surface. Her show is on until April 2.
