Gallery Review

The Elliott Fouts Gallery - Sacramento

Located at 1831 P St., in Sacramento, California, the Gallery is housed in a cool, modern viewing space with white walls, white panels, bare floors and an industrial looking ceiling. The Gallery specializes in works by local California artists. The City has tons of galleries, but this one is a standout.

A current featured artist is Michelle Andres, who does very stark California landscapes. She uses abstracted shapes of trees, grass, and a flat "color blocking" type of style, giving her work a surreal, even pop art like style.

The Gallery has special monthly shows and sells older works as well. Most shows feature modern style still life, landscapes, and seascapes. Some truly abstract works make their way into the mix, and the curators seem to favor vivid, bright colors in their experimental works. Reds, yellows, and other sunny colors predominate.

Well known Bay Area artists like Deladier Almeida, Robert Arneson, Wayne Thiebaud, and ceramist Julie Clements are shown here. However, one artist (not terribly famous) on display is a standout - photographer, Jim Millet. One item, "Clouds and Brush, Owens Valley" is special. Done in 1988, it is an unearthly, dramatic black and white desert scene. Vivid darks and lights define a moonlit desert sky, with flowing brilliant white clouds giving off a brightness, an air of movement alongside the stillness of desert sagebrush. The bushes themselves are alive, with deep shadows, highlighted with pinpricks of bright light. Lights and deep shadows define everything. You An unforgettable visual experience.

Gallery is open Wednesday through Friday, 10am to 5pm, and Saturday and Sunday, 11am – 4pm.
