Good News!


The FSVAA has been awarded a \$5,000 grant. This Grant will be divided into ten \$500 grants and awarded to ten members.

Gallery Review

The Bedford Gallery (*located at 1601 Civic Drive, Walnut Creek,*) is connected to the Dean Lesher Arts Center. The current show has a unique theme: "Sight Unseen". The show, open until September 17, 2023, features the work of blind artists from all over the world.

One artist, Evgen Bavcar, lost his sight as a child. He does very high contrast pictures of historic sites, objects, and people. Several appear to be collages of differing images.

One, *Hanna Schygulla*, blends an image of the famous actress with fresh leaves and a large bird, a new, surreal style of movie poster.

It is hard to believe that these artists are blind. Some, like Pete Eckert, seem to have a nice sense of color and composition, often better than many sighted photographers.

One outstanding work - "Monique 1" is a strange image of a female figure, wrapped in tin foil and seemingly on fire. The meaning of this?

Who could ever know?

One artist, Kurt Weston, has produced a series of mask-like images, lined up on the walls, looking for all the world like creepy death masks.

All these works are housed in an industrial strength spartan white environment that resembles a ghostly factory. A few other pieces are on display in the front hall. A fine viewing experience in a relaxed, inviting space.
