Gallery Review

The John Natsoulas Gallery, located at 521 First Street, in Davis, California, is quite the local landmark. It has been a fixture in Davis cultural life for a very long time. With its quirky architecture and imposing sculptures, it is instantly recognizable. Recently, the Gallery featured a show by local artist, Pat Mahony. Her work can be found online and in many local shows. The show, on until June 24, featured a large series of oils, mostly florals and landscapes. Her style and palette are distinctive, impressionistic, and vivid. Some works are huge, and better viewed from a distance. There are lots of complementary colors, yellows and greens, vivid reds and purples and pinks.

A large Gift Shop features dozens of fine ceramics. A number of pieces are by local artist, Esther Shimazu. She creates fanciful, plump oriental figures, often in porcelain, with fantasy touches. Artist Lisa Clague has an interesting piece, The Happy Couple (2022), which depicts a royal couple (of mice?) dressed in elegant costumes and gilded crowns.

Cute, and very surreal.

The Shop also features some large works by fabled California ceramist, Robert Arneson - in the permanent collection. Arneson helped

pioneer a certain gonzo, tough guy type style in the seventies and eighties. There is also a large collection of serious art books, mostly about ceramics, graphics and painting.

Scattered collections of small ceramics (mostly human faces and animals) are also on display.
